Government vehicles and taxis have been converted to condensed natural gas (CNG) engines. Sustainable lighting, recycled paving, green roads and subsurface irrigation are being incorporated in our extensive multi-modal transportation network.

Abu Dhabi provides quality outdoor living and experiences. Hundreds of kilometres of shoreline and dedicated public shores offer year-round recreational opportunities, facilities and events, catering to a variety of community social and cultural needs.

A sustainable environment explains our City, being awarded the Arab world's Top Green City and Most Environment Friendly City.

Seventy-eight parks and playgrounds have been added to our community since the establishment of our first park in 1975. An additional one-hundred fifty-six are currently under development. Over twenty square metres of public green space per person enables choice with sports, fitness, arts, water play, and edutainment.
