



THE ECOLOGICAL PATHWAY


Ecological pathway was found in 1982 on own initiative of Yuri Bepalov who was historian, photographer, artist and honorary citizen of Pushchino.

Zaochie is a land located on the right riverside of Oka river between its tributaries — Skniga and Besputa. The beauty and originality of the landscape were deeply appreciated when builders were looking for an appropriate place for the new town — Pushchino in 1954.

An unusual neighbourhood of modern facilities with wild nature resulted from careful planning and designing. Architects and town planners did everything to save the natural landscapes and cautiously insert a small town above the hill.

Guided by the formula: beauty is natural, they left the riverside primordial without any concrete and stones. The northern flank of the hill is 300 meters in width and stretches for approximately 2 kilometers. It was not transformed by the builders and become as basis for the newly organized ecological pathway in 1982.

Now it looks as an open air museum. The path is located in a manner to accumulate all the memorial places: ancient or innate on its way. Each point whether it be a natural reserve or an old object are marked with information board. The extension corresponds to 2 kilometers in space which takes up to 1.5-2 hours for going with excursion.



THE ECOLOGICAL PATHWAY

In the early iron age (several centuries BC) on this hill settlement of forest farmers and breeders of Dyakovo culture (Finno-Ugric) was located. Tribal system, hunting, fishing and slash-and-burn were typical for this people. This settlement was able to keep several tens of them. At that times Oka river was a natural boundary between people speaking Finnish and Baltic languages. A small spring which today keep on running in the neighbourhood could serve as a basis for selecting the place for settlement.

According to archaeological excavations on of Pushchino settlement there is also an ancient Russian horizon (XI-XIII centuries). It means that after Finno-Ugric people settlement was inhabited by Russian. Pushchino settlement at that times was like a nearby village of Teshilov city which is only two kilometers to the west by Oka river.

Botanical and entomological reserve «Steppe» History of opening

In 1887 MSU professor N.P. Kaufman on the left bank of the Oka between the villages of the Meadows and Zibrova found up to fifty species of plants areas of which are located close to the south in the forest-steppe areas and divided them into a special Oka flora. Here in the meadow-steppe plant communities he found more than a hundred species of southern plants: grasses, fescue, steppe cherry, hazel Russian, steppe timothy, tulip Bieberstein and many other.

Meadow-steppe species: zopnik klubnenosny (*Phlomis tuberosa* L.), meadow sage (*Salvia pratensis* L.), small rue (*Thalictrum minus* L.), yellow scabious (*Cabiosa ochroleuca* L.), fescue grooved (*Festuca valesiaca* Huds), *Calamagrostis* terrestrial (*Calamagrostis epigeios* (L.) Roth), wormwood field (*Artemisia campestris* L.).

Ornamental plants: false butterbur (*Petasites spurius* (Retz.) Reichenb), common shiner (*Echium vulgare* L.), mordovnik krugloglovy (*Echinops sphaerocephalus* L.), bell packed (*Campanula glomerata* L.), *Artemisia* medical (*Artemisia campestris* L.) and so on.

In the reserve you can find *Saxicola* grassland and yellow wagtails. It is also home to rare butterflies; rakitnikovaya zheltushka (*Colias myrmidone*), Common shashechnitsa (*Melitthea cinxia*), ox-eyed satyr (*Maniola jurtina*), notched copper-butterfly (*Meleageria daphnis*), tolstogolovka (*Muschampia tesellum*) and other.



Theories of origin of Oka flora

According to one of the versions seeds of steppe plants were brought here by water from the riverhead of Oka from the south. Steppe species were also able to be brought here by human.

For example, a horse-drawn carts loaded with hay that accompanied the cavalry of the nomads, who went on Moscow through the Oka river till the XVI century. Rooks and barges were sailing here from time immemorial, which were bringing a variety of shipments from the southern localities.

Village Pushchino was named after the nickname of its first owner Pusha who lived in 1500s. His family worked for government and got lands on the right bank of Oka for that. Later the young scientific center was named after village Pushchino.

It is known that in 1925 in Pushchino village there were 42 wood houses (22 of them had roofs made from straw), 230 residents, 16 gardens, 37 horses, 31 caws, 82 sheep, 60 pigs and 13 hives.





THE ECOLOGICAL PATHWAY

The left bank of Oka river in hydrological sense is situated in the southern part of Moscow Artesian Basin. In the geological section of this basin several limestone aquifers and clay waterproofs of carboniferous age are repeated. Inclination of these layers is near to 1-2 m for 1 km in the north direction (to the center of basin). These aquifers come to the surface 30-70 km to the south from Pushchino in Tula region where they get supply due to atmospheric precipitation. On the slope of Pushchino town hill aquifers are cut by Oka valley resulting in the origin of artesian springs. Hydrocarbonate — calcium water of these springs has mineralization 0.3-0.4 g/l.

THE ECOLOGICAL PATHWAY

A mansion house in Pushchino began forming in the sixties of XVIII century. The building bloom happened at the end of XIII century when Yakov Artsybashev became the owner of estate and started with construction of new house. By 1799 a big two-floor stony house was finished. A composition axis formed by stairway coming down through the park and ponds connecting the mansion with Oka river. A river panorama could be seen from the highest stair point. Builders composed an extremely beautiful landscape using a characteristic relief. In XIX century this country estate changed its owners for several times. In 1890 Sergey Perlov who was a tea seller in Moscow bought the house. He dredged the ponds, strengthened their sides and cut all sick or old trees. The last lord of manor was a manufacturer Kashtanov. From 1913 to 1917 he started with reconstruction which was the reason for change of houses appearance. The main front looking to Oka river was decorated with antique masks, garlands and sculptural frieze. A central part of the park was cleared too and this helped to open a former sightseeing to Oka. Famous people were often the guests of the mansion.

One of them was **Andrey Bolotov** who was major Russian naturalist and enlighteners of XVIII century.


The other honorary guest was a composer **Alexander Alyabiev**. He visited Pushchino mansion for multiple times and usually played his compositions here. In 1940 he got married with the owner of house – the widow Ekaterina Abrosimova.

In present time Pushchino is also popular visiting place for many artists and actors. The main building was used when the film "Lame lord of manner" was produced in 1929.

Also a famous Russian producer Nikita Mikhalkov chose this wonderful place for making his film "An unfinished play for mechanical piano".




Located on the banks of Oka river, the preserve was created with the aim of protecting outcrops of karstic limestone that are unique to the Moscow region. Such features as: outcrops of limestone, karst landforms (caves and sinkholes) and springs.

During the early and middle Carboniferous (330 - 360 Mya), the region was at the bottom of the sea. Chemical and biogenic sediments resulted in the formation of limestone, which now holds such fossils as corals, sponges, gastropods, nautilus, worm traces.


Limestone (CaCO_3) is soluble in the water in the presence of CO_2 . Rainwater and groundwater dissolves limestone resulting in the origin of caves. As a rule, caves are correlated with cracks where the degree of water filtration is maximal. Sinkholes are natural depressions caused by failure of rocks in to the cave or by dissolution of limestone under closed drainage conditions.

As a result of high water ability, Karstic limestone provide large supplies of underground water. On the other hand, it is necessary to understand that construction in karst regions is difficult and could be performed only after serious engineering and geological investigation.

Teshilov settlement

In XII-XVI centuries here was located settlement of Slavic tribe Vyatichi. Rampart and deep ditch are still preserved. In the Middle Ages rampart was crowned with wooden walls and towers. The place where gates were situated is easily recognized.

Teshilov is the same age as Moscow and is mentioned in chronicle in 1147.

In XIII century Teshilov was under terror of Mongolian and Turkish invasion.

In 1382 and 1408 Teshilov was ransacked by Golden Horde.

During XV century warriors from Golden Horde had been coming to Oka more than 10 times.

In XVI century Teshilov was a part of defensive system "Bereg". The aim of this system was to protect fords on Oka river. Oka was a kind of natural barrier for nomads.

During XVI century Crimean khans had been making plundering raids to Oka each five years.

In XVII it turned out that Teshilov was located in the central part of country so it lost its strategic importance. Little by little Teshilov changed from fortress to peaceable village with a church. Parish of Teshilov church included Pushchino village. The wooden walls of the fortress burned and were never restored.




